- Toward Settlement Service Business Deployment in China

We are pleased to announced that T-Gaia Corporation (Head office: Shibuya-ku, Tokyo, President & CEO: Tetsuro Takeoka, hereinafter called "T-Gaia") has made a capital & business alliance with Avantouch Systems Pte Ltd.(Head office: Singapore, CEO: Lee KiaHwee, hereinafter called Avantouch) engaged in prepaid settlement service business and providing various services in convenience stores (hereinafter called "CVS") in China utilizing Multi Media Kiosk (hereinafter called MMK) terminals called "alaDing" as of today. As a result, T-Gaia will hold approx. 5% shares of Avantouch.

In China, who has the world largest population of around 1.4 billion, SNS games and EC site on smartphones are rapidly growing in a similar way in Japan. Avantouch has installed self-developed MMK terminals at each CVS and has been offering a wide range of content services such as sale of points for SNS game site who has hundreds of millions of members, payment for mobile-phone bills as well as EC site, exchange of various points, purchase of movie, concert & flight tickets, application for travel and subscription to insurance in China. Until now, Avantouch has placed alaDing terminals of approx. 400 in total mainly in Shanghai area not only at Japanese-affiliated CVS but also at local CVS in China. Within the next two years, Avantouch will gradually expand its service channel until the total number of CVS with alaDing terminals reaches up to 6,000 while strengthening O2O (Online to Offline) services (*).

T-Gaia has offered prepaid settlement service business selling PINs(Personal Identification Numbers) as well as Gift Cards at approx. 45,000 CVSs in Japan as the largest Japanese mobile-phone distributor. From now on, T-Gaia intends to expand its settlement service business also in China by utilizing the know-how and operational function of Avantouch. Moreover, it plans to provide content service providers in Japan with service and settlement function using alaDing terminals.
