## ■ Topics

In October, the company achieved a +12.0% year-over-year increase in total sales across all eyewear stores in Japan. Existing stores contributed with a +6.9% year-on-year increase in same-store sales.

Same-store sales rose +6.9% year-on-year, driven by continuous promotional activities and higher average purchase prices per customer following efforts to enhance in-store customer engagement.

As of the end of October, the total number of eyewear stores in Japan was 551, representing a net increase of 6 stores.
