

**Isetan Mitsukoshi Group's near-term GHG target
has been validated by the SBTi**

Isetan Mitsukoshi Holdings Ltd. (Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; Toshiyuki Hosoya, Director, President, and CEO) announces that its greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets through 2030 have been validated by the international climate initiative SBTi (Science Based Targets initiative).※1



The Isetan Mitsukoshi Group recognizes climate change as a material issue for management. We have set “Contributing to a Sustainable Environment and Society” as one of the four Priority Initiatives (Materialities※2) that guide our efforts to achieve sustainable growth while contributing to a sustainable society. One major initiative under this Materiality is reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

The targets approved by SBTi are as follows.

<2030 Greenhouse gas emissions Reduction >

Scope	Reduction Targets
Scope1 + 2	Reduce by 42% compared to fiscal 2023
Scope3 Part of category1	Reduce by 25% compared to fiscal 2023

The Isetan Mitsukoshi Group aims to practice sustainability management by addressing various social issues through its business activities and by reinvesting the profits generated from those efforts into its management capital to help solve the next set of social issues. Going forward, we will continue our efforts to achieve these targets and work toward realizing our VISION — “a retail group centered on extraordinary department stores working toward improving the lives of our customers.
