# Notice regarding Non-Operating Expenses (Foreign Exchange Losses)

GLORY LTD. (the "Company") hereby announces the recording of non-operating expenses (foreign exchange losses) for the nine-month period ended December 31, 2016 (April 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016) as follows:

### 1. Details of non-operating expenses (foreign exchange losses)

The Company recorded foreign exchange losses of \$4,623 million in the six-month period ended September 30, 2016 (April 1, 2016 to September 30, 2016). Due to the recent fluctuations in currency exchange rates, the Company has recorded foreign exchange losses of \$2,820 million as non-operating expenses in the nine-month period ended December 31, 2016 (April 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016).

This is mainly due to revaluation of foreign-currency denominated assets and liabilities of the Company and its consolidated subsidiaries as of December 31, 2016. The amount of non-operating expenses is subject to change depending on the future trends in currency exchange rates.

## 2. Future Outlook

The financial forecast for the full fiscal year ending March 31, 2017 announced on July 28, 2016 has not been revised because the amount of the non-operating expenses (foreign exchange losses) may change due to fluctuations in currency exchange rates. The Company will announce promptly if a necessity for revising the financial forecast arises.
