Expanding Senior Housing Business

Entering nursing care services and private nursing home businesses

Tokyo Tatemono Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President: Hajime Sakuma) is positioning the senior citizen housing business as an area of focus. Recently, in a move to expand its business fields, the company has entered the nursing care services and private nursing home businesses, adding on to the senior housing with support services business that it has been implementing. Tokyo Tatemono plans to fortify its product lineup and soft services for senior housing.

■ Reasons for entering the nursing care services and private senior residence businesses

We have developed and managed the Grapes Series senior housing with support services since we opened the Grapes Asakusa in 2009.

In expanding the senior housing business, we decided to enter the nursing care services business as it believed a richer lineup of hard services and soft services would provide further security to customers. We also entered the private nursing home business to facilitate the Group's provision of housing that suited the changing health condition and needs of its customers.

■Entry into the nursing care services business

On September 1, 2014, we launched sales at a new company, Tokyo Tatemono Senior Life Support Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President: Hisatoshi Kato) that will primarily engage in nursing care services and the development and management of senior housing. We aim to fortify our lineup of services and the Grapes brand through the seamless business development of hard and soft services.

■Entry into the private nursing home business

On September 1, 2014, Tokyo Tatemono acquired full ownership of SEIAIEN (Head Office: Saitama City, Saitama; President: Shinya Watanabe), a company that manages private nursing homes. We plan to strengthen the product appeal of SEIAIEN nursing homes and develop and manage Tokyo Tatemono Group private nursing homes.
